



# STONE BANK FARM MARKET

At Stone Bank Farm students will learn sustainable, organic farming practices and where their food comes from through planting and harvesting. They will also gain insight into the relationship between farmland preservation, soil health and locally grown food by making and enjoying their own snack or lunch.

Participants will be engaged in hands-on activities in our greenhouses and outdoor gardens. Unique and specific activities will be tailored to each individual group and age level. Our knowledgeable staff and volunteers at the farm can provide you with these learning opportunities:

## Field Trip Offerings:

### PRESCHOOL

Approximately 1.5 hours

**Sample of Daily Activities:**

Harvesting, washing, chopping, and eating organic, farm fresh snack; seasonal read aloud; and nature-based art project.

\$8 per child

Minimum – 12 children

Maximum – 24 children

*\*One chaperone required per 4 students*

### ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Approximately 2-3 hours

**Sample of Daily Activities:**

Harvesting, washing, chopping and preparing organic, farm fresh produce for snack or lunch; planting, composting and watering; group games; specific lesson plan; and nature study.

\$10 per child/snack • \$12 per child /lunch

Maximum – 40 children

*\*One chaperone required per 6 students*

### MIDDLE SCHOOL & HIGH SCHOOL

Approximately 2-3 hours

**Sample of Daily Activities:**

Harvesting, washing, chopping and preparing organic, farm fresh produce for snack or lunch; planting, composting and watering; group games; specific lesson plan and environmental study.

\$10 per child/snack • \$12 per child /lunch

Maximum – 40 children

*\*One chaperone required per 8 students*
